CHARTER

Tennessee Juvenile Courts Association

The undersigned natural person or persons, having capacity to contract and acting as the incorporator or incorporators of a corporation under the Tennessee General Corporation Act, adopt the following charter for such corporation:

- 2. The duration of the corporation is <u>permanent</u>

To promote the general acceptance of the juvenile court worker; to provide a vehicle for sharing solutions to common problems; to create an avenue for exchange of ideas and techniques employed in the areas of administration, detention care, probation services, and the court clerk's office; to unite in the acceptance of a standard of conduct and a code of ethics; and to aid in the development of community correctional programs and services in Tennessee.
